## CLASS DESCRIPTIONS:

### Celebrate Recovery's Purpose

Is:

- To provide fellowship and celebrate God's healing power in our lives, using 12 Steps and 8 Recovery Principles (based on the Beatitudes, Matthew 5), which are Christ-centered.
- To help us work and apply these principles so we can grow spiritually change.
- To open the door to change by sharing our experiences, strengths and hopes with one another.
- To help us learn about God's grace, to accept His grace and to experience freedom from our compulsive, dysfunctional and addictive behaviors.
- To help us grow in the peace, joy and serenity that is only found in Jesus Christ.

(All of the following groups are Christ-based, utilizing the 12 Steps and their Biblical Comparisons and the 8 Beatitudes.)

### Newcomers—Room 101

This is a group that everyone attends once. It will help you learn which group is best for you and get you plugged into that group. That is how you get started. At that time any other questions that you have will be answered.

### Men's Healing

This group will help men who are or have been alcoholics or addicts, by employing the 12 Steps and 8 Beatitudes in this faith-based sharing and recovery group.

### Co-Dependency

Co-dependency is a group for those who need others to make them happy and give them the feeling of a full life. It is for women who have all types of hurts such as anger, low self esteem, abuse, and grief, as well as the pain of seeing loved ones who use or are recovering from chemical addictions. It also deals with the issue of enabling and truly learning to help not only themselves, but also their loved ones.

### Women's Abuse

This group is for women who have experienced any type of abuse. It will begin in the fall of 2007 and be led by a certified abuse counselor. These people will learn that they are not alone and that there is hope to find healing and move into a life of recovery. They will also find this to be a place of safety without fear of being judged or discredited in any way. Here they will support each other in prayer, friendship and dependency on the Word of God to direct their lives.

### For Men Only—Men's Issues

This Men Only group offers men the opportunity to discuss anything they want in a safe, confidential environment.

### Anxiety/Depression Workshop

Led by someone who has recovered from anxiety and depression in his life, he utilizes a very successful faith-based program. This is an 18-week program with a small group following to gradually transition into a life where each person will be able to continue his/her own life successfully without the daily experience of anxiety and depression.

### Weightloss

This faith-based weight loss group is based on what one eats, nutrition, exercise and how the Lord can help them reach their goals. By sharing with each other they realize this is a problem suffered by many and there is a way to overcome it.

### Teens 12 & Up

Led by young women who have had life issues at an earlier age, this group is for teens who need to address their unique situations and understanding of what is taking place in their lives, good or bad. Here teens can learn how God can and does work in everyone's lives.

### Singles

If you are single for any reason, this small group is for you. It deals with issues facing singles, sometimes divorce, but the overall goal is to live the way the Lord wants them to live and face their hurts, habits and hang-ups.

### The Basics of Personal Finance

This is a Christ-based program helping you with your budgeting, debt management and reduction, building for your future, giving and more in this broad topic of money. This class will be led by someone who has had personal experience with the plan he uses as the basis of the workshop. This begins in the fall of 2007

### Youth (6-11)—Room 118

The children/youth will experience a time of learning, Bible Stories, art projects, playtime, snacks and movie time. The curriculum for this group (Attitudes) addresses the attitude and experiences of this broad age group.
